# FLIGHT ITINERARY

# ESTIMATED EXPENSES 2010

- \$2,000 RT airfare
- \$2,300 10 nights accommodation
- \$400 air / ground transport in Kenya
- \$100 tips (trip leader will offer guidance)
- \$90 Hotel night Nairobi (Double Occupancy)
- \$10 Sheldrick Orphanage (or group donation)
- \$100 side trips
  - Camel Ride \$30
  - Horseback ride \$20

# TYPICAL TRIP ITINERARY

- Days 13
  - Day 1 - travel to Nairobi Kenya through Amsterdam or direct
  - Day 2 - arrive Nairobi at 8:25 pm
    - shuttles to Hotel
  - Day 3 - Breakfast, then flight directly to Lewa

  - AAZK discounted price at Safari Camp


# TRAVEL DATES
